SHILOH NATIONAL MILITARY PARK SHILOH INDIAN MOUNDS

Distance: **1.3 miles** | Terrain: **Paved**

Level: **Moderate**, elevation changes | Lit: **No**

Hours: Dawn-Dusk (Same hours as the Shiloh NMP)



POINTS OF INTEREST:
Native American earth mounds along with other structure remains; Educational signs; portion of trail provides view of the Tennessee River; trees; wildlife; historic sites.

Restrooms: at Park Visitors Center

PICKWICK LANDING STATE PARK INN WALKING TRAIL

Distance: **1.2 Miles** | Terrain: **Paved**

Level: **Easy** | Lit: **No**

Hours: 24 hours (hike at own risk)

POINTS OF INTEREST:

Lake,
Close to the Inn,
Butterfly garden



Restrooms: **Yes**

ISLAND LOOP TRAIL

Distance: **2.8 miles** | Terrain: **Dirt**

Level: **Easy** | Lit: **No**

Hours: 24 hours (Hike at own risk)

POINTS OF INTEREST:

Trees, Wildlife, Lake

Restrooms: at **Campground**

SAVANNAH

HARDIN COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL JIM CARROLL STADIUM WALKING TRACK

Distance: **0.25 miles** | Terrain: **Paved**

Level: **Easy** Lit: **Savannah City Street Lights**

Hours: 24 Hours (Hike at own risk)

POINTS OF INTEREST:

Near tennis courts, fenced tracks

Restrooms: **No** (unless the concession stand is open)

SAVANNAH CITY PARK

Distance: **1 mile loop** | Terrain: **Paved**

Level: **Easy** | Lit: **Yes**

Hours: **24 hours** (Hike at own Risk)

POINTS OF INTEREST:

Near a disc golf course, baseball field, playground, picnic area

Restroom: **Yes**

SAVANNAH HISTORIC DISTRICT

Distance: **2 mi.**

Terrain: **Paved sidewalk**

Level: **Easy**; recently added and upgraded sidewalks

Lit: **Yes**

Hours: **Open 24 hours** (Keep in mind this is a residential neighborhood. Be respectful)

POINTS OF INTEREST: 42 Historic homes (private residences); Near downtown shopping, dining, farmers market, Tennessee Street Park, Tennessee River Museum, booklet describing the homes and their architecture is available at the Tennessee River Museum.

Restrooms:

Available at the Tennessee Street Park at the east end of the historic district during the hours of 6:30 am – 10 pm (m-sat) / 6:30am – 9pm (Sunday) and the Tennessee River Museum during the hours of 8 am-5pm (M-Sat)/ 1pm – 5 pm (Sunday) Farmers Market facade entrance on Main Street



TENNESSEE STREET PARK

Distance: **0.25 miles** | Terrain: **Paved**

Level: **Easy**; ADA Accessible | Lit: **Yes**

Hours: 6:30am-10pm (M-Sat);

6:30am-9pm (Sunday)

POINTS OF INTEREST: Inside fenced in park, concession stand, located in the Savannah Historic District

Restrooms: **Yes**



SAVANNAH VETERANS PARK

Distance: 'about a quarter of a mile'

Terrain: **Paved** | Level: **Easy** | Lit: **Yes**

Hours: **Open 24 hours**
POINTS OF INTEREST: Monuments representing each U.S. war up to the present; Brick honoring names of men and women who have served in the military; Flags representing each branch of the United States military; Parking lot located next to walking trail.

Restrooms: **No**



WAYNE JERROLD'S PARK

Distance: "Less than a quarter mile"

Terrain: **Paved** Level: **Moderate**;
elevation changes and steep hills

Lit: **No**

Hours: 7am-11pm; Winter hours: 7am-5pm

POINTS OF INTEREST:

View of the bridge, Tennessee River, located near a portion of the Trail of Tears Waterway; near a boat ramp and pavilion



CRUMP

CRUMP CITY PARK

Distance: **A little under a mile**

Terrain: **Paved** | Level: **Easy**

Lit: **No**

Hours: **Dawn-10pm** (hike at own risk)

POINTS OF INTEREST:

Small wildlife; trees; playground, tennis courts, picnic pavilion, basketball court

Restrooms: **Yes**



WALNUT GROVE

Distance: "Just shy of a mile"

Terrain: **Paved** | Level: **Easy**

Hours: **24 hours** (Hike at own risk)

POINTS OF INTEREST:

Walnut Grove Farmers Market; Playground; Community Center

SALTILLO

Distance: **0.25 miles** | Terrain: **Paved**

Level: **Easy**

Lit: **Yes**, plus security cameras | Hours: **24 hours**

POINTS OF INTEREST: ballfield, playground, tennis courts, basketball court, pavilion, benches

Restrooms: **Yes**, Open March-November

PICKWICK DAM VIEW

Enjoy a sidewalk stroll along the banks of the Tennessee!

Terrain: **Paved**

Lit: **Yes**
