



Even though Tennessee's fishing is excellent year-round, it is best in the spring and fall. Fall fishing is an undiscovered bonanza. Water and weather conditions are almost always favorable in September, October and early November.

Pickwick Lake Facts:

Pickwick Lake includes more than 43,000 acres of water with nearly 500 miles of shoreline and stretches some 53 miles between the Shoals, Alabama and Pickwick Landing, Tennessee. Fishing conditions include shallow stump flats, well-defined channels, active feeder creeks, steeply falling bluffs, rocky ledges and long grass beds.

Yellow Creek access located off of Hwy 57 South near the MS line





Pickwick Lake Reciprocal Agreement ALABAMA / MISSISSIPPI - Pickwick Lake -Applies to anyone with a valid Sport Fishi License from Tennessee, Alabama, or Mississippi. Resident anglers of the three states may fish without purchasing a non-resident license anywhere within the boundaries covered by the agreement. The reciprocal area includes all impounded water from Pickwick Dam upstream to ennessee River Mile 224.8, at the mouth of Bear Creek, but does not include Bear Creek and does not include that portion of ellow Creek above the Hwy, 25 Bridge.

Fishing licenses go on sale February 18 each year, the beginning of prime fishing, and are valid until the last day of February the following year. Most licenses, except the Lifetime Sportsman License and specialty licenses, such as Wheelchair, Disabled Veteran, SSI (Supplemental Security Income), and Blind Fishing licenses, are available from most county clerks, sporting goods stores, hardware stores, boat docks, online, and from all TWRA offices.

Online: Log on to <u>www.tnwildlife.org</u> and click on the link, "Buy a license online." Regular license fees plus a processing fee will be charged to your credit card. Processing fee is \$3 if you print it, or \$4.25 if it is mailed to you.

App: Download free app - "TWRA On The Go" to purchase license. App also includes current fishing & hunting guides as well as nearby boat ramps and wildlife management areas.

By Phone: Call 1-888-814-8972. An authorization number will allow you to begin fishing or hunting the minute you hang up. Regular license fees plus a processing fee will be charged to your credit card. Processing fee is \$6.25 or \$7.50 if license needs to be mailed to you.
